FOR THE INTERVIEW

WOMEN



The Look: You want the interviewer to remember what you said, not what you wore. We recommend simple makeup and natural or subtle colored nail polish. Cover up any tattoos and noticeable body piercings, and use very little or no perfume or jewelry.

Top: Wear a nice blouse that compliments your suit. Avoid low-cut or see-through fabrics.



Avoid clothes that could obstruct your message or otherwise harm your image. Avoid T-shirts or Polos.

Suit: Wear colors such as gray, blue, black, subtle patterns, etc. Two-piece suit with either a knee-length skirt or slacks.



Avoid jeans, and dirty, torn, or baggy clothes. Avoid short skirts.

Accessories: Use a portfolio to hold your résumé without folding it. Avoid over-the-top or flashy jewelry.



Do not wear headphones or sunglasses. Avoid flashy jewelry. Ensure that any devices (phone, smartwatch, etc.) are on silent.

Shoes: Wear comfortable, closed-toe dress shoes like low heels or flats.



You want to look and feel comfortable, and be ready to have a tour of any facilities. Avoid sneakers.
